Crohn's disease

is a chronic inflammation, which can affect all parts of the intestinal tract.

Typical symptoms are abdominal pain, constant diarrhea (mostly without blood), low fever, lack of appetite, weight loss, general feeling of illness.

In Germany, there are approximately five new cases per 100,000 inhabitants every year.

Ulcerative colitis

is a chronic inflammation of the colon in phases with inflammatory ulcers which bleed easily. Typical symptoms are bloody bowel movement, diarrhea and cramping abdominal pain. In Germany, the disease affects approximately four out of 100,000 people.

Both diseases are not infectious and cannot be cured at the moment only the symptoms can be eased -
